(in this order)

- ◆ Have their teacher complete the override form
- ◆ Bring the teacher completed form home for parent/guardian review
- ◆ If parents/guardians want to proceed with the override, students must return the signed form to their counselor

→ Course Verification Letters will be sent home in the spring. Please verify both the **course and level**, and return a signed copy to your school counselor.

→ **All course requests/adjustments, including overrides and level changes, must be made by the last Friday in April. In order to facilitate construction of the Master Schedule for Western Albemarle High School, NO CHANGES, including level changes, will be made during the summer.**
