The State of Virginia requires that students take Standards of Learning (SOL) end-of-course (EOC) tests, or approved substitute tests, in specified courses in English, Math, Science, and Social Studies, and graduation requirements include a specific number of course credits and a specific number of verified credits. Verified credits are earned by passing both the course and the EOC SOL test associated with that course.
